OUR BUSINESS OPERATION AMIDST THE LATEST MEASURE FOR WORKPLACE SHUTDOWN

The latest measures by the Singapore Government for the workplace of companies not providing essential service (such as healthcare, transportation, etc) to be shut, we are glad to inform you that we have been exempted by MTI from suspension and may continue our operation from 7th Apr'20 to 4th May'20.
